Ethiopia



In Ethiopia, the vast majority of families live in poorly built, cramped homes which lack basic facilities, such as a proper toilet and clean water.

Habitat Ethiopia works at the heart of communities beside families in need. Programmes include building and renovating homes and improving access to water and sanitation.

For 14 years, people in Northern Ireland have generously supported this life-changing work through prayer, donations and volunteering. Danny volunteered in Ethiopia so it is very appropriate that the legacy build will continue that work.

Itinerary

Habitat co-ordinates everything for a safe and rewarding experience. You don't need special skills to take part. Time will be set aside every day for reflection.

- Day 1-3 Depart Ireland, arrive in Ethiopia, cultural activity & orientation
 - Day 4-8 Build and closing celebration with the community
 - Day 9-10 Depart and arrive in Ireland
- Dates dependent on flight availability.
